



Subitizing – is the ability to quickly identify the number of items in a small set without counting.

Researchers have demonstrated a strong relationship between **subitizing** skills and math achievement. We practice subitizing in many ways in the classroom. Dice, dominoes, tallies, and ten frames are all useful subitizing tools.

To play the game - turn the ten frame cards over, draw a card, and attach the itchy bitsy spider clothespin to the correct number on the water spout.
