

Tracking print from left to right with one-to-one correspondence is an important tool a beginning reader must learn. Tracking print in preschool is pointing to each word as you read it aloud. This is a skill we will practice continuously throughout the year. You can help your child at home by rereading together the predictable books they create at school. Encourage them to point to each word as they say it aloud. Back up and reread when they get off track. Fun pointers are a way to make this activity even more engaging!
